Party in the Jungle with the TD Summer Reading Club!

August 2, 2010—Blaze a trail and discover some musical jungle fun! Members of the TD Summer Reading Club are invited to attend the Clarington Public Library's wrap up celebration! The young explorers are to gather on Friday, August 20 from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. at the Clarington Beech Centre, 26 Beech Avenue, Bowmanville. This free event will have special guests, prizes from the Village Candy Shoppe, and will feature the musical safari adventures of Mystic Drumz.

The TD Summer Reading Club and the Clarington Public Library offers children 12 and under a summer packed with fun! Children can sign up for the club at any branch to receive their welcome packs, and enjoy the weekly programs that are offered at all four library branches. The program runs until August 19.

The theme of this year's TD Summer Reading Club, Destination Jungle, allows children to travel to exotic lands, explore tropical environments, and embark on an adventure of discovery of faraway places through the shelves of their public library. Every child who signs up will receive a free poster, activity book, and stickers. Summer Reading Club members also have the option of joining the Ride to Read program, which turns his or her library card into a summer transit pass. Children report on the books they have read during the summer in order to earn stickers, and chances to win a fabulous prize at the end of the summer! Each branch of the Clarington Public Library will have weekly drop-in programs with games and crafts to encourage the love of books and reading.

Mystic Drumz takes children on a global musical safari as they explore over sixty instruments from around the world including the Talking Drums of Africa and the Giant Gongs of China! Discover the cultures of Brazil, Japan, India, Cuba, Trinidad, Mexico, Indonesia, and Egypt through the joy of music and rhythm.
