Discussion Questions

“The Worrier’s Guide to the End of the World” by Torre Deroche

1. Discuss one aspect of the book that surprised you.
2. Have you ever considered going on a walking tour of another country? Would you consider one after reading the book?
3. Discuss one aspect of the book that you identified with.
4. Do you believe that the friendship between Torre and Mashe helped them get through their journey of discovery? Do you think this friendship was important and why?
5. Discuss one aspect of the book that shocked you.
6. Did you relate in any way to the characters or to their reasons for going on this journey? Explain why.
7. This memoir is ultimately about a journey through loss to self-discovery. Do you think it succeeded in relaying its objective and conclusion clearly?
8. Discuss any aspects of Italy and India of which you were unaware before reading this memoir.

Booking a Kit

- Booking may be made up to a year in advance
- Please check the calendar accessible on our website for availability
- Fill out the form with your information, and a staff member will be in touch to confirm your booking.
- Pick up your hold at the circulation desk. Your notification may come in a few days early, but it will remain available until your specified pick up date.

Terms of Loan

- 12 copies are included in each kit
- 6 week loan period.
- \$3.00 per day late fee.
- No renewals.
- Kit may be picked up at or returned to any branch.
- Kit must be returned at the desk during operating hours, not through an exterior drop box.
- All 12 items are checked out to one member's card.
- The member who borrowed the kit is responsible for:
 - The distribution and return of all 12 items to his or her group members; and
 - Any damages to the books/bag, or lost items. The cost of a damaged or lost book varies depending on the item.
