Draw a picture of what outside looks like in each season. What is different in each?

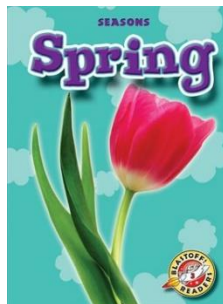
Write a list of the different types of clothing you wear in each season, and how you might get ready for each one.
