



Art Challenge: Object Images!

Challenge yourself to create art using the objects around you in a new and different way – it doesn't have to use art supplies!

Read your favourite book or look at different art pieces on [World Book Kids](#). See if you can pick out a picture you might want to recreate, such as the cover of the book, or a favourite artist's work.

Look at the different shapes that make up the image. What objects do you have that are a similar shape or colour?

The only rules are **no drawing or painting!** Try using different supplies that you might not normally use for art!

If you can't find objects that work, can you make the shape out of paper? **This type of art is called a collage** – try searching "collage" on [World Book Kids](#) to learn more about collage artists.
