Which of the animals would you like as a pet? **Draw it and write words or sentences about it in French.**

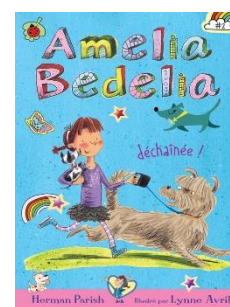
**Play Pet Pictionary!** See the next page for descriptions of animals in French you can use to play.
